



 Call and invite targeted organizations/persons to your meeting and explain why you are inviting them (Note: Ask the organization to designate a representative)

 Make sure that 'housing code' is explained during meetings






 Touch base with the invited persons after the meeting to thank them for attending and be sure to ask if any additional clarification is needed

 Foster relationships with invited persons, learn about their priorities and make them feel that their involvement is of <u>value</u> to the effort

 Encourage more than one representative of an organization/entity to be at the table so as not to lose momentum with turnover



 End meetings when you say they will end and if possible, follow-up with a bulleted, brief summary in a timely manner so that those who could not attend are in the loop




Remember to celebrate your successes on an annual basis....no matter how small!

- Defining advocacy




Addressing ADVOCACY
